

January 31, 1978 Darśana with Baba Hari Dass

Edit notes: The following was typed from notes handwritten at the time of the darśana. Q denotes a question. B indicates what Babaji wrote on his chalkboard, as read by the reader, and then as heard and noted by someone present. Comments in square brackets are generally those of the typist. Names of individuals who are not public figures are changed to protect their privacy. There was editing for format and IAST transliteration of Sanskrit terms.

Q: [A satsaṅga member] was unconscious before he died.

B: What about subconscious/subtle consciousness [Babaji's question]? All are unconscious before death.

Q: So which emotion is uppermost at the last moment is always the result of previous sādhanā.

Q: Soul's having gone out the eyes....

B: Positive was stronger than negative. Prāṇa stronger than apāna.

[According to a satsaṅga member, the soul's going out the eyes is one of the highest places. Only after nirbīja Samādhi does the soul go out by mūlaprakṛti. Nirbīja samādhi being a one-way valve, it could not come back down and go out the eyes. Babaji's sister's soul went out her eyes.]
